


National Commission for the Knowledge and Use of Biodiversity

- Interministerial Commission
- Created in 1992 by Presidential decree to:
 - promote and coordinate actions towards the knowledge and sustainable use of Mexico's biological richness
 - **biodiversity information to society**
 - > act as a **bridging institution** between academia, the government and civil society

CONABIO's philosophy

- A demand-driven research institution, but also promoter of basic research in academic institutions
- Generate knowledge and intelligence at the national scale to help conserve and sustainably manage Mexico's natural capital
- The central actors in conservation and sustainable management efforts should be the **owners** of the natural capital of the country,
- Become a world class institution in developing bioinformatics
- To be a public resource of information and knowledge on the biodiversity of the country for all levels of society


